**Overview:** A limited number of assistantships are available in all graduate programs and can be awarded to fully admitted, degree-seeking students. Individual offices on campus also offer assistantship positions.

**Requirements:** A student awarded an assistantship is required to be degree-seeking graduate student at the College of Charleston currently enrolled in graduate courses. Applicants must be in good standing in their degree programs. Out-of-state students awarded an assistantship are eligible for an abatement, which are funds that cover the difference between in-state and out-of-state tuition rates.

If a student is awarded an assistantship but will not be enrolled in at least six hours of graduate credit, the student must submit a request for a Category B Assistantship.
